Materials Accepted in the “Single-stream” Container (where everything is mixed together in one container)



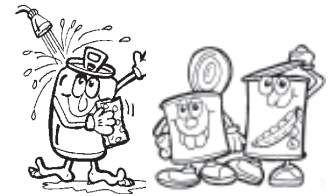
GLASS BOTTLES & JARS:

Rinse. Remove lids (metal lids can be recycled, but must be unattached). Paper labels okay. *No plate glass, drinking glasses, cookware, light bulbs, ceramics, etc.*



PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Rinse.

Most containers (e.g., bottles, jars, tubs, pails, cups, pots) #1-#7. Snap-on lids okay. *No automotive chemical or pesticide bottles. No microwave trays, party platters, plastic wrap or bags, Styrofoam, or items marked “compostable.”*



ALUMINUM & STEEL (TIN)

CANS: Rinse. Don't flatten. Metal lids okay. Labels okay. **EMPTY** aerosol cans okay. Foil and pie plates okay, but must be flat, *not* balled up.



NEWSPAPERS: Includes inserts.

Do not place in plastic bags or secure with string.



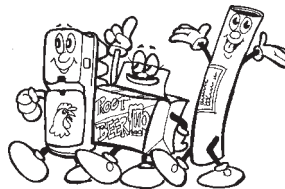
MAGAZINES & CATALOGS: *No*

glue bindings more than 1/2 inch thick.



OFFICE PAPER & JUNK MAIL:

Open junk mail and remove non-recyclable items. Includes white paper, pastel-colored paper, envelopes (windows okay), fax paper, ads, brochures, fliers, cardstock, file folders (manila or pastel). *No neon or brightly colored paper.*



PAPERBOARD AND LOW-GRADE PAPER: Includes cereal boxes, shoe boxes, paper towel rolls, wrapping paper, packaging paper, Kraft envelopes, phone books, soft-bound books. *No wax-coated materials (e.g., milk cartons, juice boxes, pet food bags). No tissue products, no neon or brightly colored paper.*
